## **Packing List**

- 1. School-appropriate clothing for Friday (no shorts, but basically what LAA allows on dress-down Friday)
- 2. Concert attire (Friday and Saturday evening)
  - a. White button-down shirt or blouse with a collar (NOT a polo shirt), will be worn with a bow-tie that will be provided (shirt can be long or short-sleeved)
  - b. black pants
  - c. Shoes are not specified in the uniform but please do not wear athletic shoes. Black dress shoes would be most appropriate but are not required.
- 3. PJs
- 4. Church-appropriate clothing for Saturday morning dresses for the girls and long pants and a nice shirt for the boys, if not a shirt and tie. Please bring clothing OTHER than your concert attire in case it gets dirty.
- 5. Two sets of shorts/jeans/comfortable clothing for Thursday evening at the fun park (laser tag, etc.) as well as for Sabbath afternoon (we often go for a hike or spend time outside at least).
- 6. Toiletries toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant, etc. some bring flip-flops for the showers.
- 7. Towels: Washcloth and towel for showering
- 8. Bedding: There will be dormitory beds with mattresses for sleeping. You can bring **either a sleeping bag/pillow or sheets/blanket/pillow**. An egg crate can be nice in case the mattress isn't super comfortable.
